

STRIP TEASE - Beginner quilting

General

- Sewing machine in good working order with all bobbins, feet and attachments (If you have a walking foot bring it)
- Usual sewing supplies - pins, scissors, unpicker, needles
- Machine threads (neutrals to match your fabric)
- Rotary cutter, cutting mat, rotary cutting ruler if you have them. Available from spotlight and quilt shops. (I will have spares to use)



Fabric

- 5-6 fat quarters (these are pieces of fabric approx. 20" square) of 100% cotton fabric. Choose your favourite colours and aim to have a mix of small and large patterned fabrics with plenty of contrast between them
- ½ metre of a fabric to use as a contrast to the patterned fabric (solid or one with a pattern that reads as solid from a distance) Can be patterned if it **really** contrasts with the rest of the fabrics

For finishing the quilt (can be bought later)

- 1-2 metres fabric for backing and binding (depends on finished quilt size)
- thin cotton/polyester or wool/polyester batting (depends on finished quilt size)
